#### Sign Permit. Discussion

Ron Brackin, of Main Drag Auto Sales, 105 East 4th South, addressed the City's Sign Ordinance. He explained he wants to place a sign on the front of his building that would cost less than the required \$200 fee for a Sign Permit, and therefore he feels the required fee is set too high. He also explained that he would like to erect an offsite sign for his other business, the Pizza Stop, 106 East  $2^{\rm nd}$  South, along the roadway on the Main Drag Auto Sales property.
