Bond Refund It was moved by Councilmember Larson and seconded by Councilmember Thomas to refund the improvement bond in the amount of \$1,273.91 to Blair Knapp, for improvements completed at 40 East 7th South. This received unanimous approval.

Chipping During Spring Cleanup After Council discussion, it was decided that the City will haul branches to the landfill this year rather than paying the extra costs of using a tree chipping service.

Festival Of Lights Committee Mayor Hendrickson presented the following names for the Festival Of Lights Committee: Mary Ann Cox, Tiffany Jeppsen, Stephanie Bodily, Derek Hobbs and Bart Wilcox. It was moved by Councilmember Larson and seconded by Councilmember Kunz to approve the above named individuals to serve on the Festival Of Lights Committee. This received unanimous approval.

County Commission Franklin County Commissioner Scott Workman reported that Franklin County is purchasing 7 acres of land adjacent to the Fair Grounds, without any water shares for the property. The Council was in agreement that the City would assist in providing water to the parcel.

It was moved by Councilmember Larson and seconded by Councilmember Thomas to adjourn the meeting at 4:53 P.M. This received unanimous approval.
