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Splash Pad Proposal

Heather Parkinson came before Preston City Council to seek support for the setting up of a splash pad in the Preston City Park.

Stephanie Strong, representing the Kiwanis, stated that she is assisting with grant applications to fund the project, and all grant money, donations, etc., will be run through the Kiwanis Club.

It was moved by Councilmember Thomas and seconded by Councilmember Harris to offer the City Of Preston's support to the plan for a splash pad within the Preston City Park. This received unanimous approval.

Land Park Industrial Preston.
